"Toys for Tots" is a program run by the United States Marine Corps Reserve which distributes toys to children whose parents cannot afford to buy them gifts for Christmas. The program was founded in 1947 by reservist Major Bill Hendricks.

The Fire District welcomes the community to participate in the drive. New, unwrapped toys for children are being accepted at Station 61 at 2123 Jackson Highway in Chehalis until Friday, December 14th. Donations can be dropped off at Station 61, 7 days a week, between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM.

If you are currently receiving Washington State Temporary Assistance for Needy Families or Food Assistance, you will then complete the form at the local DSHS office at 151 NE Hampe Way, Chehalis. DSHS is taking applications from November 20, 2018 through December 13, 2018 with distribution of toys from 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM on December 17, 2018 and December 18, 2018 at the American Legion Hall at 111 W Main St., Centralia.

Salvation Army is not taking applications for the "Toys for Tots" program this year.
